Count, measure, or weigh produce into individual portions. **Food Order Fulfillment Volunteers** are needed from 8:30am until 4:30pm on Wednesday 8/20 and Thursday 8/21 and from 8:30am until 12:00pm on Friday 8/22. Volunteers are needed to pull cases of food from inventory and to make loads ready for shipment. The ability to count, read, follow instructions and work standing are needed. **Confirm Order and Loader Volunteers** can help out Saturday 8/23 from 5:00am until 11:00am. Volunteers will double check orders and assist loading large orders onto vehicles. Volunteers age 14 and up welcome. *Choose your shift, and call the Volunteer Center for more information.*
