Need Some Fresh Air? Volunteer for Spring Ahead Day – May 3rd

Join the Interfaith Senior Programs as they help the elderly and adult disabled get their homes and yards ready for spring and summer. Volunteers are needed to provide assistance on Spring Ahead Day taking place on Saturday, May 3. Volunteers are needed to assist with set up on Sunday, May 4th. Volunteers are also needed on Monday, May 5th from 8:30am – 2:30pm to assist at the registration table, staffing coat-check, take down and other tasks. Food Drive Assistants in Milwaukee and Waukesha County - MAY 10TH

The Stamp Out Hunger food drive, the nation's largest one-day food drive, is a great volunteer opportunity for groups, families, and individuals on Saturday, May 10. Residents leave non-perishable food items by their mailboxes and letter carriers pick up millions of pounds of donated food. Volunteers are needed at post office sites in Milwaukee and Waukesha to unload letter carrier vehicles, sort food into categories, and load food onto trucks. Volunteers must be a minimum age of 12 years (Ages 12 – 15 must have an adult accompanying them). Choose a shift from 11:00am -4:00pm or 3:00pm -7:00pm to help out the Hunger Task Force and The Salvation Army. *Contact the Volunteer Center to learn more about this event.*
